

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

(Single Dog Entries)

VETERAN CLASSES

Veteran Dogs and Bitches - 6 yrs. & older At Independent Specialties Neutered dogs and Spayed bitches may compete. The winners of these classes will compete for Best of Breed

BOXER PUPPY - JUNIOR SWEEPSTAKES

Entry Fee is \$20.00 – AM show only. All entries in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class in the AM show. Entries shall be made at the same time on the same entry form used for the regular class. "Sweepstakes" and "age" division must be indicated in the space for Additional Classes on the official AKC entry form.

This Sweepstakes is open to all Boxers who, on the day of the show, will be 6 months and under 18 months of age. Sweepstakes classes will be judged prior to the regular breed classes at that show

NO CHAMPIONS OF RECORD.

The competition will be divided into six classes as follows:

PUPPY CLASSES

Puppy Dogs, 6-9 mos.

Puppy Dogs, 9-12 mos.

Puppy Bitches 6-9 mos.

Puppy Bitches 9-12 mos.

JUNIOR CLASSES

Dogs, 12-18 mos. Bitches, 12-18 mos.

The BEST PUPPY shall compete against the BEST JUNIOR, and the winner shall be designated GRAND SWEEPSTAKES WINNER.

Thirty-five percent (35%) of total receipts will be retained by the Club for expenses.

Sixty-five percent (65%) of total receipts is to be divided among the winners as specified below:

Sixty percent (60%) of the sixty-five percent (65%) will be divided equally among the 1st place winners of each class.

Forty percent (40%) of the sixty-five percent (65%) will be divided as follows:

BEST PUPPY IN SWEEPSTAKES	 25%
BEST JUNIOR IN SWEEPSTAKES	 25%
CRAND SWEEDSTAKES	50%

Cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person handling the dog, which will be considered the rightful recipient of the award. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the Sweepstakes judging is over. The show-giving club disclaims any liability for cash prizes after judging is complete. Any prize money allocated but not awarded shall be returned to the Club treasury.

FOUR TO SIX MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION

Entry fee is \$20.00 The BCOA will offer Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competitions at the AM Specialty. Entry can be made using the regular AKC Entry Form. Please designate "4-6 Month" in the Dog Show Class box. The AKC Litter Registration number can be used. The 4-6 Month Puppy Class will NOT be divided by sex. A Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex will be selected from the entrants in the class.

Please Note: Per AKC Rules, no Professional Handler will be allowed to exhibit in this class, even if they are the breeder or owner of the puppy.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 vears old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places. with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 First Place wins in an Open class, with competition, to be eligible to enter the AKC National Championship competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry on the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NATIONAL OWNER HANDLER SERIES

The BCOA will hold a NOHS event at both AM & PM Specialties.

Please check the box on your dog's entry form if you are eligible and wish to enter this special **Owner-Handled Best of Breed** competition.

Online entrants – Please check the Owner Handler Eligible box, or write 'NOHS' in the Additional Classes box.

Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

AWARD OF MERIT

At the Judge's discretion, Award(s) of Merit will be awarded to Boxers who are in serious competition for Best of Breed awards. It shall be entirely the judge's decision to award all, some, or none. Awards of Merit shall be awarded to dogs and bitches other than the Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex, and Grand Champion Select winners. The AOM criteria is as follows:

5 Champions – 1 AOM 10 Champions – 2 AOM 20 Champions – 4 AOM

Best in Puppy Classes: The First-Place winners of each of the four puppy classes will compete for Best in Puppy Classes at the AM specialty show. **Best in Bred by Exhibitor Classes:** The First-Place winners of each Bred By Exhibitor Class will compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor at the PM specialty show.

Best Veteran: The First-Place winners of the veteran classes will compete for Best Veteran at each show.

ALL ENTRIES WITH FEES MUST BE IN THE OFFICE OF THE SHOW SECRETARY NOT LATER THAN

12:00 NOON AZ TIME - WEDNESDAY - SEPTEMBER 4, 2024

after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, or signed and no entry fees refunded. Telephoned and telegraphed entries are not accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show rules.

These shows are governed by The American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the back side of the entry blank in this Premium List.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS and Photocopies of entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. NO ENTRY CAN BE ACCEPTED that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of errors after closing date.

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS & JUDGING PROGRAMS will be **e-mailed** to all entrants who provide email addresses. All others will be mailed by the USPS.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring. There is no provision for unentered dogs at this show.

THE BOXER CLUB OF ARIZONA may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it becomes impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Show Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring. THE CLUB, ITS SHOW SECRETARY, Prescott AZ KC, and Findlay Toyota Center will not be responsible for the loss of or injury to any dog or the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or other causes. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the Show premises. And, in addition, no responsibility will be assumed for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an owner, exhibitor, handler or spectator. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children at all times. DOGS MAY ARRIVE at any time prior to scheduled time of judging of their class. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Owners or handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. There is no rule of this Club or the AKC that requires a Judge to wait for a dog. TROPHIES AND CLASS CASH PRIZES will be awarded in the judging ring to the person showing the dog. In the event of any discrepancy from the published prize list, the Show Chairman should be advised at once. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

RECORDING & EVENT FEES: A Recording Fee of 50¢ per dog and an Event Services Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule, Ch 11, Sec 2)

TRANSFER OF ENTRY TO BEST OF BREED: Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the Show but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of the earliest conformation judging at the Show.

ALL RIGHTS TO PHOTOGRAPH AND VIDEO shall remain with the CLUB. By entering or attending these shows, all people and dogs grant to the CLUB the right to use their likeness and voice in any manner without further consent or release.
